If you know it's wrong, it probably is, so don't do it and all that sort of stuff. Well, this is the same thing. I'm not sure if this is the right way to handle this or not. But I'd like to think that there are people that serve in good time, without any trouble, that are in a prison cell now that could probably be put in some kind of a facility like this and they could be managed. And if they didn't, and if they use this as an occasion and circumstance to hurt and violate, dehumanize other people, then as far as I'm concerned they're...don't have any time left, good time don't count, put them in the dark cell, give them something to eat and that's about it.
