

that time, do you know?

SENATOR BROWN: Forty-five.

SENATOR WITEK: Okay, \$45 million, and then the Appropriations Committee did not want to depend on \$45 million from the federal government, so they put how many million into their budget?

SENATOR BROWN: Twenty...we put the recommended...the amount that was recommended by the administration into the budget.

SENATOR WITEK: Okay.

SENATOR BROWN: But we hedged it by having the \$20 million that would go into the Cash Reserve Fund.

SENATOR WITEK: So \$20 million of the Legislature's \$45 million went into the Cash Reserve Fund, and \$25 million went into our budget.

SENATOR BROWN: Was budgeted to go into the Cash Reserve Fund; it did not actually go into the Cash Reserve Fund.

SENATOR WITEK: Where did...

SENATOR BROWN: It was budgeted to go into this fund.

SENATOR WITEK: It was budgeted to go into the Cash Reserve and it went into...

SENATOR BROWN: It just was budgeted.

SENATOR WITEK: Just in General Funds stayed there. Okay. And we only have received...then have we received \$40 million of Maximus money?

SENATOR BROWN: No.

SENATOR WITEK: How much have we received of Maximus money?

SENATOR BROWN: The projections are 4 to \$6 million less than the \$45 million, and that's why we made the adjustment, the \$5,700,000 adjustment. But in terms of what we've actually received,...
