CLERK: LB 29A, Mr. President, a bill by Senator Wehrbein.
(Read title)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Wehrbein, to open on LB 29A.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker, members, this is for the purpose of appropriating or allowing the spending of the dollars that would come in under this program. As I understand it, the estimate, if you notice, is \$50,000 for '96-97 for the Student Loan Default Fee Revolving Fund and \$80,000 the second year from the Student Loan Default Fee Revolving Fund, which is '97-98. It's the authority to spend the estimated money that may come in under this. That is simply all it is about. There is also perhaps a need for \$3,400 the first year, \$5,500 the second year for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated this section for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this bill. That is the reason for the A bill that I had submitted.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. There are no other lights on, did you wish to say anything in closing?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Closing is waived. The question before the body is the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 29A. All in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 29A.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 29A is advanced to E & R for initial. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, may I read some items Mr. President?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Mr. Clerk, do you have some items for the record?
