SENATOR DIERKS: Okay.

SENATOR WESELY: And also there is a three-year delay which is what Senator Wehrbein's amendment did.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay now, as I recall, this would be the total amount of the A bill, original A- bill, wouldn't it, the \$20 million.

SENATOR WESELY: Right, but now it would be seven.

SENATOR DIERKS: Now it would be seven? So the numbers that you have got in here that are going to continue to be funded are the current numbers for the program?

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR WESELY: You bet. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: With your amendment...excuse me, Mr. President and members of the body, Senator Wesely.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely, will you respond to a question for Senator Robinson?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Now does that change the...you still have this chain of command chart, I call it, where you got 1044/1059...

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...does that still stay intact?

SENATOR WESELY: Right, uh-huh, that would.
