to her there too. But one thing I wanted to ask Senator Wesely, first of all, I want to make a statement. I totally support 1044, have from the beginning and certainly will all the way through. The only thing is I have a question, a couple of questions, on what we are in right now, as far as these regions. First of all, who owns the properties that they inhabit right now?

SENATOR WESELY: Well, actually there is some question about who owns some of the property.

SENATOR ENGEL: Well, if we have that question, what happens, say, the state takes over all of these functions, well then are we in a squabble with trying to figure out who the property belongs to and who is going to occupy it, what is going to happen to it or...

SENATOR WESELY: Well, it is possible. That is one of the reasons we backed off of the indigent care issue because that came up from Douglas County. But we took over the welfare system. The concern about the property issue did come up at that time but eventually you work through it and it ends up being resolved. We have been through this before. The issue always comes up and you negotiate and work through it.

SENATOR ENGEL: I know in Region IV, like all regions I believe they had problems before. I think they are working quite efficiently up there right now and the thing is, what I am concerned about, I know we are trying to streamline everything, and I totally agree with that, but I just hate to get away from local control. We talk about devolution from the federal government down to state government and I just hate to get away from. take away all local control from these, especially situations such as this.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Madam President, members of the body, I think after I have listened to everyone, we pass 1044 and we are expecting those people to come up with a plan. It seems to me that we are doing the planning for them right now. Now I am not...the information Senator Wesely passed out, I agree with part of it, but it seems to me those people, after they get their organization together, they should come up, they should
