SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. The question is the adoption of the Coordsen amendment. Those indicate by voting...roll call vote, okay, Mr. Clerk. Call of the house has been requested. Those in favor indicate by voting aye, those opposed no. Please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR WESELY: The house is under call. Please check in. All senators in their offices, please come to the floor of the Legislature. Senator Brashear, Senator Pirsch, Senator Schimek. Senator Pirsch. We're all present, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1740 of the Legislative Journal.) Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Changing to not voting.

CLERK: Senator Bernard-Stevens changing from no to not voting. 32 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR WESELY: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, anything for the record?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. I have amendments to be printed. Senator Coordsen amendments to LB 1212; Senator Maurstad to LB 299; Senator Avery to LB 642A; Senator Schimek to LB 1316; Senator Schrock to LB 604. I have a series of adds. Senator Matzke to add his name to LR 442 and to LR 443. Mr. President, Senator Withem would move to adjourn until tomorrow morning at 8:30 a.m. (See pages 1740-53 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WESELY: The motion is to adjourn. Those in favor indicate by saying aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned.
