LB 1104, 1306

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1306 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 1104.

CLERK: LB 1104, I have E & R first of all, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1104.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend the bill. (See AM4162 found on page 1605 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the amendment simply adds the emergency clause. With planting season right around the corner, and custom harvesters are going to be traveling through the state rather soon, I think it's imperative that we pass this and give them an opportunity to fully utilize this bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: On the Schrock amendment, Senator Elmer.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Appreciate Senator Schrock offering this amendment, it is very important that this be adopted, and I'd ask all of you to favorably consider adopting this amendment and then advancing the bill. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Elmer. No further lights on. Closing, Senator Schrock? Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the Schrock amendment. All in favor say aye, excuse me, vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.
