SPEAKER WITHEM: The Schrock amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1104 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 1069.

CLERK: LB 1069, no E & R, no amendments at all, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1069 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 1277.
