recreational areas, it simply allows them to recoup some of their costs with fees, if they want to do that, for the use of the recreational areas. They wanted to clarify their authority to do that. The other thing is, under the well decommissioning program that has been set up, it requires that the NRDs provide at least 75 percent of the cost of decommissioning. Several of the NRDs said they have programs that use 60 percent funding, and they wanted to be able to access the state funds, so in order to allow them to do that, there was a bill that came out of Natural Resources Committee, without dissenting vote, allowing them to do that. So those are the two changes by this particular amendment. If there are questions, I'd sure be glad to try to answer them. Thank you.
