other thing it does is to make clear that before a decision is made on a project the council has the prerogative of having a public hearing at that particular point in time. It doesn't require them to. It says that they may hold a public hearing. The original bill didn't require or mention any sort of public hearing, except in a very limited circumstance, so this just broadens it out and gives them a broader power to hold a public hearing, if they see fit. Thank you.
