LB 1085, 1226A

is not a bill which increases the budget or General Fund appropriation at all in the state, but it does facilitate the flow of this money between these two funds, and between the petroleum release, the remedial action cash fund and the federal funds, which are being received under the SRF program, so...the State Revolving Fund. So that is the purpose of the A bill, and the only purpose, and if there are any questions, I'd be glad to try to answer them.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bromm, there appear to be no questions, so you cannot answer them. Do you have closing?

SENATOR BROMM: No, I do not.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1226A advances. We now then move to the special order property tax legislation, Select File, 1996 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk, before we get there, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Not at this time, Mr. President. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, let us move then to LB 1085.

CLERK: LB 1085, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1085.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All those in favor vote aye. Opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.
