I think it's a safeguard that our property tax payers in this state need. I think it strengthens LR 292CA and I would appreciate your vote on this...on this amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. The question before the body is the adoption of the Schrock amendment to LB (sic) 292. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: It would appear that we're going to need a roll call vote, a record vote.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I want a call of the house first.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senators, please check in. Senator Schrock, did you want a roll call vote or a record? Want a roll call vote? Senator Schimek, Senator Wehrbein. Mr. Clerk, there's been a request for a roll call vote. Please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1781-82 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 15 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Schrock amendment advances or is adopted and I raise the call.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have is a priority motion. Senator Withem would move to reconsider the vote on the Schrock amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Withem to open on his motion.
