

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Very quickly once again, the fiscal note for this bill is being reduced from \$691,000 to \$325,000. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. There are no other lights on. Did you...closing is waived. The question before the body is the return to Select File for specific amendment of LB 256A. Those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The bill is returned. Senator Hudkins to open on your amendment. (AM4258 is found on pages 1706-07 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR HUDKINS: Open and close. I explained what the amendment does and I'd ask for your support.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. You've heard the closing. There are no other lights on. You heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Hudkins amendment to LB 256A. Those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad, would you care to make a motion?

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I move to advance LB 256A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing 256A to E & R say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is readvanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 642, Senator Hillman would move to return the bill for specific amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Hillman, on your motion to return.
