SENATOR BROMM: Yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I wanted us to have something on the desk. But the first thing I would do, if you look at the amendment that you have offered, is to strike subsections (2) through (6). That wipes out all the specifically named Chair...I meant committees. We leave the statement above it which says the committee shall consist, the task force, the chairperson of the Exec Board. That would stay. We strike the named committees. Then in line 6 we add...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I apologize, Senator Chambers, but that is the time on Senator Bromm's. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. I'll give the remainder of my time to or all of my time to, while I'm eating my Fritos, to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you and you'll notice his generosity didn't extend to sharing his Fritos but he knew I wouldn't take them anyway. But then this is the language that would be put in, Senator Bromm. We would leave the statement about the chairperson of the Exec Board. Then subsection (2), the new subsection (2), would say, "Seven additional members of the Legislature to be selected by the Executive Board; and". Then we would take up with that language about the political subdivisions. So the only thing being done is to strike those named committees, inserting language that points out that there will be seven additional members of the Legislature to be selected by the Executive Board and that's what the new language would be.

SENATOR BROMM: That sounds perfectly acceptable to me, Senator Chambers, if you want to offer that as a substitution.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then, Mr. Clerk, I mean, Mr. Chair, I will withdraw my amendment and offer a substitute.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.
