SENATOR MAURSTAD: Just the, yeah, the regular 4278.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Page) 1731, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk, 1731. I hope that once again when I spoke earlier that they still, whoever is going to appoint this committee and especially the five additional representatives representing the political subdivisions, that they do keep in mind that there should be good representatives of those organizations. You know, the next...that worked out, next paragraph raises an interesting question also. I mean maybe we ought to discuss whether or not the chairperson of the Executive Board ought to be the chairperson of this task force. I wonder has there been a lot of thought put into that particular...? There has been. Thank you, Senator Bromm. I'll yield the balance of the time back to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Chambers, you still have about four minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, now so that this is done correctly, just to tell you what that amendment is saying, the one that we have now. Mr. Clerk, what page, oh, because I want to give the...okay, we're on page 1731 in the Journal so what would happen is that in line 17, if you're following, thanks to the "Evil-Eye Fleegle" activity of the E & R Chairperson, we would strike subdivision (1) through (6) and insert subdivisions (1) and (2). Now you have the entire amendment. That's what's before you and I hope you will vote to adopt it.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Chambers, are you finished on your opening? We are still on the original amendment to the amendment at this point. Is there any further discussion? Senator Janssen. Senator Chambers, let me clarify. Are you withdrawing your previous amendment and substituting the thought-out amendment that you have just handed up? Again, Senator Chambers, I'll recognize you for clarification on which amendment.
