

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I shall attempt to clarify. I'm withdrawing that amendment that was before us and the one that we're taking up now is the next one on the list and that will be the one which includes the additional language that was added thanks to Senator Maurstad's Sherlock "Holmesian" approach to this bill.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator Chambers. It is withdrawn and we now have the new amendment pending. Senator Chambers, you are now recognized to open on that new amendment if you so desire.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: My opening consists of what I said earlier, and I want to again express my appreciation for the very competent sleuthing of Senator Maurstad and I hope that you will adopt this amendment. Any remaining time I would yield to Senator Bromm if he has anything he would care to add.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Very briefly, Mr. President. I support this amendment to the amendment. It's a clarification and certainly one could make a valid argument that the selection of the task force could very well be done in this manner. Hopefully, the Exec Board can appoint those people who are most interested in taking action in this area and would have the most to contribute. So it adds that flexibility and, without prolonging it, I would just say I'll support this amendment to the amendment by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Janssen. Senator Janssen waives off. Senator Klein. Senator Klein waives off. Senator Chambers to close. Closing is waived. The question is, shall the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Chambers be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Again, members, if you are close to the Chamber, we are on a vote on the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Chambers.
