

SENATOR LANDIS: Question.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I see five hands. The question before you is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: The Chair recognized me, Madam President, but apparently...never mind. The...I've been trying to apologize for doing this. As I mentioned in my opening, I'm still...and I still am up in the air on this. and in fairness to those who originally asked me to carry it, it came up so quickly I had to continue to carry it because they had not arranged for anybody else to do so. I...since then, the new language came down. It's been given to another senator who I think will do so. I don't think it is fair for me to get up and try to urge voting for something that I'm not sure I'm going to vote on. So the new language is here. Somebody else can introduce it. So with that, Madam President, I would ask that the amendment be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen would move to amend the bill. (FA615 is found on page 1853 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Kristensen to open on his amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature, as I begin this if Senator Janssen is within ear shot, here comes Senator Janssen. Senator Janssen, I'll let you listen to my opening. On your amendment 4375, we had the discussion probably 45 minutes ago or so about the judgments that are due to a subdivision to the extent the judgment is not paid by liability insurance coverage of a governmental unit.
