PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner to open on his amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this is a clarifying amendment. It's on page 1606. First, there's an internal correction of dates within the bill, strikes '97-98 and insert '98-99. Secondly, there...this is the bill that deals with some of the cooperative programs and the use of funds, including the local option county sales tax, if voted, but there is reference to the five cents that's in 1114 for cooperative efforts of cities and counties, and this is to clarify that the five cents that's referred to in 1177 is the same five cents that is in 1114. There was some who thought it was two separate items rather than the same. Then finally the other provisions were suggestions from the Revisor's Office that refers to the local option sales tax, if it is imposed, but it harmonizes those positions in this bill with the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967 as amended. It is corrective, harmonizing. I would ask that the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there any discussion of the Warner amendment? Seeing none, Senator Warner to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 1177. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted.
