SENATOR BEUTLER: (Laugh) Thank you very much, Senator. That's all.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Senator Withem mentioned exactly what I was going to rush over there and ask him could we do, have a point where we get together and not have to try to scratch something together right now because on this bill I want anything that I offer to really say what it is that I want it to say and, although I might want to go beyond that, I don't want a particular amendment that I'm purporting is to accomplish a certain goal to accomplish something else through inadvertence. I want each thing that I offer to be clear so that we know what it is we're putting in the bill if it's adopted, or what's being rejected if it's not adopted. So at some point that's what we'll do. But, Senator Withem, I was just talking to Senator Matzke and it..a suggestion might be to have some kind of form that the company could put together that would, you know, like when you calculate your .the amount of taxes you're going to have to pay or whatever you'd have coming back and then it would be...it would take care of the notice requirement, it would be the means by which the verification occurs and then, as you and Senator Beutler seemed to be talking about, I missed some of it, the employee signs it or something like that. But we all know, because I do wind up filing state taxes at some point or other, you don't have to send them a copy of your federal income tax form in order for your filing with the state to be complete. So maybe what I will do instead of continuing to ask questions, at this point any other thing that I have if Senator Withem didn't mind I'll bring that up when we come together and then, if we reach a disagreement, then I could say it on the mike for the sake of the record. But since you have agreed to work it out, I'm willing to not spend additional time at this moment since you're amenable to answering the questions when we work on whatever amendments we would put together.
