LB 634, 1226A

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I do have a slight amendment to LB 1226A which is the A bill which allows the Cash Fund transfer between the Petroleum Release Fund and the Waste Water Treatment Revolving Fund. The only change is not in amount, but it moves up the possibility of the transfers to June from July, which the DEQ came to me and indicated that if we would do this, they might be able to start paying the back bills or the unpaid bills a month earlier than they could if we had left the July date in there, so it's a...it doesn't change any figures. It's simply to facilitate possibly some earlier payment of the back bills under the Title 200 Fund. And if there are any questions, I'll be glad to try to answer them.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there...Senator Bromm, there are no lights on. Do you care to close on your amendment? The question is the adoption of the Bromm amendment to LB 1226A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I would move to advance LB 1226A to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, I believe we are on LB 634.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad, E & R amendments first of all, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 634.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay. The question before the body is the E & R amendments to LB 634. All of those in favor say aye. Opposed. We are...the E & R amendments are adopted.
