

What is that all about?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. There are not...Senator Beutler. Senator Preister. As I understand what we're doing right now, and I apologize for my conversation up here. Senator Beutler, you were directing a question to Senator Preister. Is that correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right. I was hoping there were further answers.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd like to direct a question to Senator Bohlke, please.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Senator Beutler. This was a very small technical part of the amendment. It was already in the bill. It simply was a...a request from the grain elevators and that we restate the technicality that was already in there. And so it's mainly a restatement of really what was already in the bill. And so, it is a change desired by the grain elevators. It requires major source emissions to be used when figuring what the emission fee costs would be, under the 50 emissions, 50 percent permit fee structure proposed in the amendment. That was, most people thought, already stated in the bill, but it's just a reassurance.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER WITHEM: There are no further lights on. Senator Preister waives. The question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. Speaker, you just voted for Senator Crosby.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Well, I appreciate Senator Crosby's wisdom in this circumstance.

SENATOR CROSBY: If you want to vote, you're going to have to
