SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor vote aye. Opposed. E & R amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers has an amendment to the bill. Senator, Floor Amendment 598.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers.

CLERK: It's found on page 1650 of the Journal.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I have to see, Mr. Speaker and Mr. President, what that amendment is. It's on which page of the Journal again.

CLERK: 1650, Senator, 1650.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Oh, yes. I don't see the amendment itself.

CLERK: It's Floor Amendment 598.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, 598. Oh, yes. This one I want to ask Senator Brashear about, to see how he feels about it. Senator Brashear, this is an amendment that would have said, "any person" in place of "resident of Nebraska" who can apply for these plates. And as I stated the other day, if you want to leave it restricted to only a resident of the state being able to make application, I'm not going to fight on it, but that's what this amendment would...would do.
