

does...and I found all the places in the bill where it would apply. Beginning on page 2, in line 2, before Spirit, I want to insert the word "Holy." And the only differences that you'll see in the insertion of the word, in some places the word "Spirit" is capitalized, so Holy would be capitalized. Other places in the bill where spirit has a lower case "s" beginning...starting it, the word holy would also have a lower case. But in any event, since we're dealing with what amounts to a religion, I think we ought to make it clear that we're talking about the Holy Spirit. So that is my amendment. If you have any questions, I would be glad to answer them. And we're restricting this only to the people within the state of Nebraska so there'll be no proselytizing outside of the state as far as allowing those people to purchase, to make application for these plates, but you could drive your car wherever you wanted to and advertise to the world the type of state Nebraska is, our values, and the things we consider important, and so forth. So it would...these would just be the Holy Spirit Plates.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Chambers, there are no lights on. Would you like to close?
