

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Withdraw.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senators Beutler and Bernard-Stevens would move to amend, Mr. President. (FA622 found on pages 1897-98 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. This is the amendment I was referring to that Senator Beutler brought up the idea facilitated by Senator Brashear, I believe agreed to by Senator Kristensen. I'll give him and Senator Beutler some of the opening. What this will do is go back to the original portion of the bill that says any amount after the first \$5 million distributed between campuses of state colleges and University of Nebraska for athletic facility costs, will strike the word "athletic." So at least the facilities will be educational facilities. It could be any facility. At least it's dealing more with education which, you know, sometimes you take the small step if you can't get the large one, and I appreciate members working on that. Senator Beutler, did you wish any time of the...Senator Kristensen, I'll give you. Senator Kristensen said he has lights on so that's the nature of the amendment. I will give the rest of my time to Senator Beutler.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Bernard-Stevens, I wasn't listen closely. Did you mention the part of it that throws the first 10 percent over \$5 million back into the player scholarship?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: No, sir, I didn't and I'm glad you brought that up...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, that's part two.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: ...because that 10 percent still is in there, Senator Chambers, where that first 10 percent goes back to the scholarship fund.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.
