LB 1076, 1264, 1264A

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, the closing will be brief. I really believe that this concept of Husker spirit is kind of of the people, by the people, and for the people and I'm happy if the colleagues agree to pass the bill for the people. I want to express appreciation to Senator Chambers and to Speaker Withem for cosponsoring the bill and to Chairman Kristensen and the Transportation Committee and for everybody else who worked to make this happen. It was more complex to coalesce than things far more difficult. I would urge advancement of the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body is, shall LB 1264 be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Excuse me, all those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, we will pass over LB 750. I believe the next bill up would be LB 1076. LB 1264A, pardon me. I'm jumping the gun a little bit. LB 1264A, Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1264A to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Now LB 1076.

CLERK: LB 1076 has Enrollment and Review first of all, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1076.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Heard the motion. All of those in favor say aye. Opposed? The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Will.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Will would have the first amendment. Is Senator Will here?

CLERK: He's actually excused, Mr. President.
