SENATOR WESELY: Most of them get Medicare certified and so there is that standard they have to meet.

SENATOR CROSBY: So it...yeah, okay, I wanted to be sure I understood all that...

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah. And so they have those standards. But, no, I don't see the hospices being harmed at all or they wouldn't be supporting this, so.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I just rise in support of this amendment. I do feel that hospice programs do provide a good service and benefit to patients. Thank you.
