CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Senator Warner, amendments to LB 1290 to be printed; Senator Withem to LB 1375. I have a proposed rules change from Senator Avery, be referred to the Rules Committee. And I have an amendment from Senator Wesely on LB 1076, Mr. President. And Senator Abboud would like to add his name to 1375, Senator Maurstad to LR 292CA.
