SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will now continue with Final Reading. Members, if you'd take your seats, we can begin Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, proceed to read.

CLERK: (Read LB 1189 on Final Reading.)

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1918 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, on the final passage of 1189, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1189 passes with the emergency clause attached and while the Legislature is in session, capable of transacting business, I would propose to sign and I will sign Legislative Bill 1189e. Excuse us. We're getting our act together here. Just a momentarily we'll be ready to go.
