

want an agency going out here and running wild and putting on additional fees and additional items out there that are higher. Now I think as a practical matter, what's occurred here is there is not going to be an agency that is going to go out and do that because of what has occurred with this legislation, and what's happened to the Library Commission. And from that point of view, I think LB 1375 has probably accomplished that fact, but if you adopt Senator Bromm's intent on Section 4, unless you take a reading that electronic access is different than, let's say, a certified copy, which I probably would make some argument for, this is a very difficult subsection. I also, Mr. President, may...

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...I ask Senator Bromm a quick question, please. And, Senator Bromm, let me ask the question, on your own time or if I have some time I will give it to you. We've got several phrases in the statute, I just quickly went through and called them up on the computer and found out where we have access records. Some of the records say we can charge reasonably necessary fees, some say a reasonable fee, some say actual cost, some say, the Treasurer, for example, may set the fee schedule. Are we talking about statutorily set dollars and cents or are we talking about in a case where it says that they may charge a reasonable amount, are we talking about the fee that is customarily being charged as of the date of the legislation?
