PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We turn now to Select File and LB 750.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad, E & R amendments on 750, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 750.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 750. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the first amendment I have to the bill, Senator Landis, AM4332. I have a note, Senator, that you wish to withdraw 4332 and substitute therefore AM4434. (Landis substitute amendment is referred to on page 1791 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LANDIS: Correct.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any objection? There's an objection. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I'll take up the bill...I'll take up the amendment as it currently is offered, and I'll...and I won't offer it at this time. I'll redraft it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Landis, to open on the original amendment. (Landis amendment, AM4332, is found on page 1889 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, I believe there's a motion to suspend the rules.

CLERK: Madam President, there is, yes, sir. The motion is Senator Landis would move to suspend Rule 7, Section 3(d) to permit consideration of AM4434...or 4432.
