The last amendment, had we been on General File, had we been taking these in the ordinary course instead of saying you got a couple hours to do your work and then we'll...it's kind of one of those "we'll give you a fair trial and then we'll execute you" sort of positions. That last amendment that we voted on was a very legitimate, substantive amendment which changes existing law regarding what brewpubs can do, a substantive amendment. This amendment is a substantive amendment which says the library system is what we ought to be discussing. And we will have other substantive amendments, but I don't want to get hooked into that procedural thing and I don't think I've been...the time that I've spent has been talking about the issues. This is an amendment that deals with library systems. If we want to discuss library systems this year, there ain't no other chance to do it. If we want to discuss, if we really stand by what we say and that is that libraries are important, if we stand by what we say and we are going to prioritize, then this is a vote that we need to take and I'm giving you the opportunity to vote on that. I would urge that the motion to suspend the rules be adopted. Madam President, I would waive closing. If there's no other lights on, we can go ahead with it. I would waive closing. I would ask for a call of the house and machine vote.
