

brewpub legislation? And again, I...my intent is to do I guess...I think I've got two or three others of these, I have...did not take a great deal of time on the last one and I don't intend to take a great deal of time on this one, but I do, I guess, intend to make a record of where we prioritize things because we have to know that when we vote for these things that is exactly what we're doing. And so with that, as I mentioned, AM4347 would...would provide for a reduction in income taxes. I think we all know what the bill as introduced would do and what the amendment would do and I would simply urge that I guess we express our preference for priorities and, Madam President, I am...will be putting up, to get it in proper procedural order, I am putting up a motion to suspend the rules to permit consideration of this amendment because I believe otherwise as it is it would be nongermane.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I'll waive off.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Senator Lindsay, excuse me.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, Senator Lindsay would move to suspend the germaneness rule to permit consideration of AM4347.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Again, Madam President, I have...I'm not going to take a ton of time here. I'm just going to say that what this would do again procedurally, same place where we were on the initial vote and this would be for the income tax reduction. The...I don't need to explain the bill. I think it's been.. if not debated in committee it was certainly debated I think in the newspapers, so we know what it does. I know some of you have expressed interest in that bill. With that, I would urge that the rules be suspended to allow...permit consideration.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Seeing no further lights, Senator Lindsay to close on his motion. Closing is waived. The question before you is the motion to suspend the rules to take up the Lindsay amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.
