PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...suspending the rules on a bill that has had an hour and a half, two hours debate to get to it. We've got a cloture process. Don't even want to go to that. Never had first round debate. Won't have Final Reading debate. I suspect it's not what George Norris envisioned, but it's something we do on important issues. I hope...I hope expanding the capacity of brewpubs is not one of those.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Seeing no further lights, Senator Landis, to close on the motion to suspend.

SENATOR LANDIS: Could I ask for a call of the house as this time is going on? Clearly, we're going to need everyone here.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. The question before you is the question to call the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
