in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Lynch's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on this bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 1190A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance 1190A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We'll go ahead to Final Reading. We will pass over LB 307 and move to Final Reading. Will the senators please take your seats for Final Reading. Oh, I'm sorry, yeah. LB...Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 901 on Final Reading. The first motion I have is by Senator Coordsen. Senator Coordsen would move to return the bill for specific amendment, the amendment being to strike the enacting clause.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: I'm going to withdraw this amendment in just a moment but the reason for this amendment was simply to remind the body that the section that we put in relative to the problem that had developed with people who had insurance getting their licenses removed necessitate the emergency clause on this bill. And as we vote on 901, I would encourage you to remember that when you make your decision. With that, I would withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen would move to return the bill for specific amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen.
