CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is returned. Senator Withem on your amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Again, it establishes a June 1 effective date for the...certain provisions of this bill including the penalties, the speed limit on the expressway system, the construction zone change. I would urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: There are no lights, Senator Withem. He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Withem amendment to LB 901E. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Withem amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: We need to readvance the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 901E to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 901E to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
