But there are communities based on value, based on what and how the properties sell for that have caused in some circumstances where people are disabled a serious problem as it applies to their eligibility. So I appreciate the fact the Revenue Committee and Senator Warner would address the issue and I hope we support the amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator Lynch. No further lights. Senator Warner, to close on the motion to return. Waives closing. The question is shall LB 1039 be returned to Select File for specific amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Again, senators that are close to the Chamber if you could check in, please. We have a vote in progress. Have you all voted? We are voting to return LB 1039 for a specific amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The motion to return is agreed to. Senator Warner on the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd ask the amendment be adopted.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: You've heard the opening. You may have heard the closing. Are there any further lights? Senator Warner, I assume you're waiving closing. The question is, shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We're voting on the Warner amendment. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is agreed to. On the motion to readvance, Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 1039 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: You've heard the motion. Is there any discussion? The Chair seeing none, all those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
