SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 575 pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1992 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 575 passes. LB 948e.

CLERK: (Read LB 948 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 948 pass with the emergency clause attached? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1993 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 948 passes with the emergency clause attached. Let me introduce guests of Senator Pedersen, 65 fourth graders from Westridge School in Elkhorn. They are in the south balcony along with their teachers. Could you stand and be recognized. And for the record, Senator Robinson also had some guests, 48 seniors from Fort Calhoun School. They were in the north balcony along with their teacher. With that we...1258 will be passed over. We'll move to LB 256.
