SENATOR WARNER: Correct.

SENATOR WITEK: ...that spends \$260,000 in the next two years and establishes a new commission.

SENATOR WITEK: Yes.

SENATOR WARNER: The one before would authorize \$100,000 each year, yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Warner, would you like to close on your motion to return?

SENATOR WARNER: I'd just ask the body to return to permit the adoption of this amendment that clarifies that levy-setting process for the two instances I've talked about.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill.
