LB 465A, 624, 750

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All of those in favor of returning LB 465A to Select File vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 465A is returned. Senator Kristensen. (See FA645 on page 2034 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would appreciate a vote to strike the enacting clause at this point in time. That would be an affirmative vote to kill it.

SPEAKER WITHEM: No further lights on. The closing...you've heard the closing. The question is, shall the amendment which would strike the enacting clause be adopted? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays to strike the enacting clause, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The enacting clause has been stricken. The bill is no longer among the living bills in front of us. LB 634.

CLERK: (Read LB 634 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 634 pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2034-35 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 634 passes. LB 750, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay would move to return the bill for a specific amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Lindsay.
