SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I'll just speak very quickly. I think I only talked once about this bill all through the discussions. But I did pass around to you today "Drive Safely" from a firefighter and paramedic who gives the statistics one-tenth of a second, all it takes is for the front bumper and chrome of the grillwork to collapse. By the time you get to seven-tenths of a second, when you are going 55 miles an hour and hit a tree, the entire body of the car is forced out of its shape as hinges tear, the doors spring open, the seat rams forward. I'm not going to read the rest of it 'cause I think it's so awful. What concerns me about this bill today and some other bills that we haven't gotten to at this time is we do not give an example to our young people. We...the people who want to go really fast I always.. we put in the new penalties, but I don't think that that will deter people from going five miles more than 75 miles an hour on the interstate. And we have raised some on the state highways that I think are going to cause trouble. We don't give a good example on liquor. We
