SPEAKER WITHEM: I think that's probably correct.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay, I was just making sure that none of those got on the record. I'd hate for you to be able to read that year after year after year.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, in the words of Senator Preister who seems rapidly on the way to replacing Senator Bernard-Stevens as one of our wordier colleagues, I'd like to say a word or two in behalf of Senator Withem. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: I would just like to conclude with my gratitude to all of my colleagues, I appreciate the time we spent together; and as we rapidly come to conclusion, I'm especially grateful although I appreciate and respect and love all of you, I'm especially grateful that I've made it through the entire session and not one of you actually gave me that dreaded legislative crud. SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1373 passes. LB 1373A.

CLERK: (Read LB 1373A on Final Reading.)
