SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1373A pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2073-74 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1373A passes. LB 1375.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1375 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1375 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2074-75 of the Legislative Journal.) Vote is 46 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1375 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, we will now move to confirmation reports Senator Wesely, I believe there are two confirmation reports on Journal page 962. Mr. Clerk, can you introduce the first of those.

CLERK: Senator Wesely's first report, Mr. President, on page 962 involves appointments to the Nebraska Board of Health, Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board, Director, Department of Social Services.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the Health and Human Services Committee did hold a hearing on February 21 regarding these appointments. They are Patty Kuehl to the Nebraska Board of Health; Dr. Charles Ihle to the Board of Health; Elaine D'Amato to the Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board, she indicates she's no relation to Alfonse D'Amato; Director of Department of Social Services, Don Leuenberger. The committee voted six to nothing in favor of these appointments, and I offer them to the Legislature for confirmation.
