SENATOR WILL: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. Speaker, members, not remembering this confirmation report, it's because Senator McKenzie handled this confirmation, and I'll turn the confirmation report over to Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR WILL: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, excuse me, Mr. President, and Senator Bohlke. You know, Senator Bohlke, I had a sneaking suspicion you were going to do this to me so I was actually prepared. I would like to recommend for the full Legislature's confirmation Dr. Keith Vrbicky. He is, just very briefly, a very dedicated public servant, manages to find time outside of his medical practice to be involved in numerous activities in the community. He has a very legitimate interest in coordinating the activities of postsecondary education across the state, answered our questions and we did manage to give him a rather thorough questioning in front of the committee; and we believe that he will be a tremendous asset to the postsecondary or the Commission for Postsecondary Education. With that, I would highly recommend the Legislature's confirmation.
