SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Withem, members of the Legislature, the Committee on Natural Resources wishes to report favorably upon the appointment, proposed appointment of Marquis Reed Gilmore to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission notwithstanding the appearance on his behalf of Senator Matzke.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Seeing none, closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.
