

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Let's just go ahead and have a call of the house and then we'll have a roll call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. The question, the question before the body is a motion to call the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, the house is under call. Senators please check in. Senator Robak announces that the following guests are visiting the Legislature. There are students from Columbus Middle School here, with their instructors. They are sitting both in the north and under the south balcony. Will you all stand and be recognized please? Welcome to the Nebraska Legislature. Senator Coordsen, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Avery, Senator Lindsay, Senator Lynch, Senator Pedersen. Senator Chambers, Senator Coordsen, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Hilgert, Senator Wickersham. Senator Withem and Senator Landis. The question before the body is the motion to override Governor's veto. Senator Bernard-Stevens requested a roll call vote. Senator Wehrbein requested it in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2096 of the Legislative Journal.) 9 ayes, 27 nays on the override, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion to override fails. The next motion. And I raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Coordsen would move to override the Governor's line-item veto with respect to Section 78.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Coordsen to open on his motion to override.
