

to bring Nebraska and your abilities on-line, to coin a phrase, with where they should be in the information age and in keeping with your individual responsibilities and in keeping with the responsibilities of the total body politic that we represent in making those decisions. I only wanted to offer this amendment this morning for the opportunity to visit with you just a little bit so you're not too harsh with the Exec Board if there's a time when you want something and you think you desperately need it and the money isn't going to be there. We will make it work. We will make it work well. I think the Governor in sending a symbolic message that we're spending too much money picked what may have been in my mind the wrong topic because we spend countless millions in the other branches of government, countless millions, we're spending who knows what in the millennium project. We don't even know how much money we're spending in that and yet \$80,000, remember that this project is being put together by Legislative Council staff at a small fraction of what I read that other states are spending to do programs, to do Chamber automation systems and may not in fact be as well thought out and as full of opportunity to help this body in making those decisions in the future. And with that, Madam President, I would like to ask unanimous consent to withdraw this motion.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any objection? Seeing none, it is withdrawn.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Crosby would move that Section 94 of LB 1189 become law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Crosby to open on her motion to override.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam President and members. I am bringing motion to override the Governor's veto on the developmental disability aid. If you're looking at the handout that you received from Appropriations this morning, it's on page 3, the second line from the bottom, three point hundred and seventy thous...three point million...three point a hundred seventy thousand two hundred ninety-five dollars, three million one hundred seventy two hundred ninety-five dollars. I will first read from the budget message from the Appropriations Committee that you have on your yellow sheet if you have it.
