Pedersen. Would you like to proceed? Yes. Senator Hudkins has requested a roll call vote in regular order. The question before you is the motion to override the Governor's veto. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2098 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 13 nays on the override motion, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion to override fails. I raise the call. Any further motions to override? Pursuant to our rules, I hereby sign certificate regarding Legislative Bill 1189, having been returned by the Governor with his signature but with certain items therein line-item vetoed. The Legislature, by the constitutional majority, has overridden said line-item veto as follows: Section 93, line 19, Agency 25, Program 365 in the Department of Public Institutions. (See Communication from the Secretary of State and Certificate on pages 2098-99 of the Legislative Journal.) We now turn to... Before we turn to legislative resolutions, the Chair recognizes Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, Madam President, members of the body. I just...my recom...to talk about the rest of the day, we're kind of at an awkward point where we have completed our look at the overrides and passing of legislation, but we really can't get through the full agenda here in the next 15 minutes or reasonably within the next half an hour or so, so what I would propose that we do as far as the rest of the day is concerned is that we...is that we proceed with the next resolution that is published, because I understand, Senator Dierks, there's some people here for that particular resolution, then that we recess, come back after lunch. There are a couple of other resolutions that have been filed, deal with those, deal with the confirmation report and the other unfinished business. So, case people are making plans, that is at least going to be my recommendation. Probably, at the conclusion of Senator Dierks' consideration of his resolution, I will be moving to recess.
