The question before you is the adoption of legislative rule...legislative resolution 743 (sic). All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. It's 473. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, on the adoption of LR 473.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LR 473 is adopted. LR 475.

CLERK: (LR) 475, introduced by Senator Stuhr.
