

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1190

Approved by the Governor March 21, 2000

AN ACT relating to county agricultural societies; to amend section 2-259, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1999; to provide for the acquisition of certain real property; to change provisions relating to an additional tax levy; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 2-259, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1999, is amended to read:

2-259. Pursuant to a request by a county agricultural society, the county board of any county may levy an additional levy of three and five-tenths cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable valuation, or any part thereof, for the purpose of acquiring an interest in real property to comprise a portion or all of the county fairgrounds or for the purpose of capital construction on and renovation, repair, improvement, and maintenance of the county fairgrounds, over and above the operational tax levy authorized in section 2-257. Such levy shall not exceed the amount actually required for such acquisition or work and - ~~In counties having a population of more than sixty thousand inhabitants but not more than three hundred fifty thousand inhabitants and also containing a city of the primary class, such additional levy or any part thereof may be levied for the purpose of capital construction on and renovation, repair, improvement, and maintenance of the county fairgrounds or the Nebraska State Fairgrounds. The additional levy shall be subject to section 77-3443.~~

Sec. 2. Original section 2-259, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1999, is repealed.
