PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Gavel.)

CLERK: ...Senators Bromm and Hudkins as the representatives to the Executive Board; Second Caucus, Senators Chambers and Lynch; Third Caucus, Senators Engel and Jones have been selected.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Coordsen to approve the Caucus Report.
